- Class 7 ... In-hand young stock 1, 2 or 3 years old. If sufficient entries, will be judged separately
- **Class 8** ...In-hand Family Horse Pony exceeding 13 hands 2 inches
- Class 9 ... In-hand Arab or part Arab
- Class 10 ... In-hand Veteran horse / pony over 15 years
- **Class 11** ...In-hand Coloured horse/pony (Piebald, Skewbald, Palomino, Appaloosa, and Spotted). If sufficient entries, will be judged separately
- Class 12 ... In-hand Mountain and Moorland pony. To be shown in natural state
- Class 13 ...IN-HAND & RIDDEN FANCY DRESS (No entrance fee)

RING THREE Start 12.30am - RIDDEN CLASSES

- Class 14 ... Novice lead-rein pony not exceeding 13 hands 2 inches. Riders 8 years or under
- Class 15 ... Novice first ridden. Not exceeding 13 hands 2 inches. Riders 12 years or under.
- Class 16 ... Ridden best turned out pony 14 hands 2 inches
- Class 17 ... Ridden best turned out horse 14 hands 2 inch and over
- Class 18 ... Best Ridden Cob
- Class 19 ...Best Ridden Arab or part Arab
- **Class 20** ...Best Ridden Coloured horse/pony (Piebald, Skewbald, Palomino, Appaloosa, and Spotted). If sufficient entries, will be judged separately.
- Class 21 ... Ridden Veteran horse / pony over 15 years
- Class 22...Lead-rein Mountain and Moorland. Riders 8 years or under. To be shown in natural state
- Class 23 ... Ridden Mountain and Moorland horse. To be shown in natural state.

Show Championship for Ridden and In-hand Classes

The Show Championship for Ridden and In-hand winners will be judged as a separate class after the all the relevant classes have been completed. All those who have been placed 1st or 2nd in the Showing Classes (Ridden or In-hand) will be judged for the Chorley Show Ridden Champion and Reserve Champion and Chorley In-hand Champion and Reserve Champion.

Trophies to be presented during the Show. Trophies are to be signed for and held by the winner for one year and returned in time for presentation at the following year's show.

Health and Safety Issues

All entries are accepted on the understanding that the rules are strictly adhered to. The rules and regulations pertaining to the show will be available from the Show Organiser when booking in. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. A veterinary officer will be on call.
